Dear Youth and Young Adults of Brooklyn-Queens,

Daily Itinerary - Unexpected circumstances may cause changes to the outlined itinerary.

Day 1 Sunday, July 30: Depart for Lisbon or Madrid

This evening we'll depart (New York area airport) on our overseas pilgrimage to Lisbon, Portugal for the 38th World Youth Day celebration. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board.

Day 2 Monday, July 31: Arrive in Lisbon or Madrid I Fatima

Late morning, arrive at Lisbon International Airport, claim our luggage and a Peter's Way Tour Manager will meet us upon exiting Customs. Board our comfortable tour bus and we will be on our way to Fatima. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** Independent lunch.

Group dinner at our hotel. At 9:30 pm, we'll participate in praying the Rosary in the Chapel of the Apparitions, followed by a Candlelight Procession with the shrine statue of Our Lady.

Overnight at hotel in Fatima.

Day 3 Tuesday, August 1: Fatima I Lisbon

Breakfast at our hotel. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine. This morning, our guide will take us on a tour of the Shrine of Fatima. In May 1917, Our Lady was seen several times by three shepherd children-Jacinta, Francisco and Lucia—at Cova da Iria, where the Basilica now stands. Visit the tombs of the children and the Chapel of the Apparitions, known as the Capelinha. Continue on to visit Aljustrel, the hamlet where the three children lived, and view their untouched homes. Visit Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared after the children's return from prison. Pray the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way) built by Hungarian refugees, which culminates in the Chapel of Calvary, overlooking all of Fatima. Finally, visit the church where the children were baptized. Independent lunch. After lunch, we'll leave Fatima to Lisbon for hotel check-in. (Pick up location of WYD Registration Packets to be advised). This afternoon we'll participate in the World Youth Day Opening Mass, presided over by the Cardinal-Patriarch of Lisbon, and concelebrated by bishops and priests from around the world. Independent dinner.

Day 4 Wednesday, August 2: Highlights of Lisbon I Catechesis

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we'll have an orientation tour of Lisbon. Begin with a visit to the Church of St. Anthony, where in 1195, St. Anthony Patron Saint of Portugal was born. Then, we'll stroll through the old quarter to visit the Cathedral, housing St. Anthony's baptismal font. Pass by the Belem Quarter, Belem Tower, 25 April Bridge, the Discoveries Monument, and St. Jerome Monastery. World Youth Day participants will have the opportunity to attend various catechesis sessions with participating bishops. Free afternoon to participate in WYD activities.

Day 5 Thursday, August 3: Catechesis Papal Welcome & Youth Festival

Breakfast at our hotel. World Youth Day participants may attend morning catechesis sessions with participating bishops and **celebrate Holy Mass**. Participate in the ongoing WYD activities today with opportunities to meet your fellow pilgrims. While you may not speak the same language, you will

find it easy to communicate, because God's love knows no boundaries. Independent lunch. This afternoon we will gather for the arrival of our Holy Father, Pope Francis (location to be advised), hear his message of welcome and pray together! This will be one of the greatest experiences and memories of World Youth Day. Youth Festival activities continue throughout the evening.

Day 6 Friday, August 4: Cathechesis I Way of the Cross

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, World Youth Day participants will have the opportunity to attend various catechesis sessions with participating bishops and **celebrate Holy Mass**. Our day concludes with The Way of the Cross. The World Youth Day Cross is carried in a procession during this service and together we will follow a designated route through the city, giving testimony to our faith. We will be united with young people from all around the world as we meet the Crucified Christ in Lisbon.

Day 7 Saturday, August 5: Prayer Vigil with Pope Francis

Breakfast at our hotel. Our hotel rooms will be secured for the evening, so pack appropriately for our overnight campout. We will join the multitude of pilgrims on a walking pilgrimage to the vigil site. Activities will include testimonies of young people, music, prayers to the Blessed Mother, etc., as we prepare for the Vigil. This evening, the Holy Father will address the youth of the world and lead us in Adoration, Prayer and Benediction. Tonight's outdoor sleepover will be another great opportunity for us to share our faith and love for the Lord, and to think about new ways in which we can bring the Holy Father's message home to our friends and families. There will be a space reserved for Adoration of The Blessed Sacrament. *WYD Registration Packet includes meal passes for lunch & dinner today. Overnight at the Vigil Site. (B)

Day 8 Sunday, August 6: Transfiguration of the Lord - Mass of Sending | Farewell Dinner

Boxed breakfast from hotel. This morning, the Holy Father will concelebrate Mass with thousands of bishops and priests, and he will address young people and those who are not so young, to send them out to the world as witnesses to the faith in imitation of Our Lady. At the end of the concluding Mass, the Holy Father will announce the place where the next World Youth Day meeting will be held. Receive Holy Communion in the presence of the Pope, and carry Christ's love with you forever. At the end of Mass, the Holy Father will announce the place where the next World Youth Day meeting will be held. This will be an experience you will never forget. Independent lunch. This evening we will celebrate these days by sharing a festive dinner with our Shepherd, Bishop Brennan.

Overnight at hotel in Lisbon.

Day 9 Monday, August 7: Return Home to the USA

After breakfast at our hotel, we'll be transferred to Lisbon (or Madrid) Airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. If paying with a credit card, the price is \$175 higher than the cash discounted price featured in this brohcure. Peter's Way Tours (PWT) reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: All tour payments are non-refundable upon receipt. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable and non-transferrable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on tour roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements for all countries on this itinerary. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2023, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes estimated round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Rates will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing.

AIRLINE SEATING: A group booking will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

PORTERAGE: Porterage of one piece of luggage per person at hotels is included. Porterage at airports is not included.

ACCOMMODATIONS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$950.00 will apply.

MEALS: Breakfast daily at hotel (boxed breakfast August 6). Hotel dinner on arrival day and farewell dinner in Lisbon. The WYD Registration fee (estimated at \$300 ans subject to change) includes meal card/passes for meals as noted on the itinerary.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities and tips are included in your travel package (\$50 per person). All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave one Euro (1,00) per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants purchase insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for nonrefundable payments, damaged luggage, or trip interruption. We also strongly uggest that you purchase the Cancel For Any Reason upgrade in order to cover your travel investment for unforeseen circumstances that are not covered by PWT as noted above under OF RESPONSIBILITY. PWT offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help ensure the well-being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc (see chart below).
