Our Goal

Each participant will have an opportunity to hear the Gospel (kerygma) from a seasoned Young Life speaker and to respond as a conscious disciple of Jesus Christ. Over the course of the weekend, we will provide each parish group with the opportunity and space to talk about what it means to be a fully initiated Catholic and an active parishioner. There will be ample time for the facilitation of tasks related to the sacrament of Confirmation specific to each group. Each night in the cabins, your leaders will help to facilitate discussions related to the speaker's talk and to help chaperone. Our goal is to put kids in front of Jesus – highlighted by ending Saturday night with Eucharistic Adoration and Mass together on Sunday morning.

Mother Olga of the Sacred Heart is the founder and mother servant of the Daughters of Mary of Nazareth, a Roman Catholic religious order in the Archdiocese of Boston. She was entrusted with the mission of founding the community in 2011 by Cardinal Séan Patrick O'Malley, O.F.M. Cap. Born in Kirkuk, Iraq, into the Assyrian Church of the East, Mother Olga Yaqob lived through four wars in the Middle East.
